The Michigan Center for the Book is accepting applications for the 2010 grant program until Jan. 15. Application guidelines and the application form are at www.michigan.gov/mcfb.

The program is open to Michigan-based nonprofits, libraries and schools. The requests for funds must be for literary events that are free and open to the public, and that will occur in 2010. Funds requested may be for up to \$500 or 50 percent of the event budget, whichever is less.
